ORDINANCE No. 187915

* Authorize grant agreement with the Latino Network, not to exceed \$51,571 to employ one full time street level gang outreach worker to provide intervention services within the City (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Since 2008 violence related to gang activity has continued to increase in the City of Portland, and it has become necessary to direct funds to provide street-level gang outreach services in the city.
- 2. The City of Portland recognizes the need to address youth violence problems in a way that respects all members of the community, empowers the community to solve problems with assistance from the police if needed and uses comprehensive, best-practice solutions.
- 3. The City, through the Office of Youth Violence Prevention (OYVP), manages and oversees the Street Level Gang Outreach Grant Program, established in 2009. The program is modeled after a nationally recognized best practice acknowledged by the Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA).
- 4. The City Council approved additional funding to be applied to new Street Level Gang Outreach Worker positions through the 2016 / 2017 FY budget. Through this funding the Office of Youth Violence Prevention seeks to increase culturally specific services to Portland's Latino population through the Street Level Gang Outreach Grant Program.
- 5. Latino Network has been selected to receive funding for one full time employee to serve as a Street Level Gang Outreach Worker.
- 6. Latino Network, a local private non-profit youth service organization, currently provides services to youth and their families who have been impacted by the gang lifestyle through the Multnomah County Community Healing Initiative (CHI). Latino Network's CHI program is currently connected through client service provision to the Portland / Multnomah County Gang Impacted Family Team Program as well as the City's Street Level Gang Outreach Program.
- 7. Council has appropriated the Office Youth Violence Prevention funds associated with this grant agreement. These Youth Violence Prevention funds are currently included in the FY 2016-17 adopted budget.
- 8. The amount of this grant is not to exceed \$51,571.
- 9. The grant agreement will be effective for a one-year period from August 1, 2016 to July 31, 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, is authorized, on behalf of the City, to execute a grant agreement in an amount not to exceed \$51,571 and in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The funds associated with this grant agreement will come from the Office of Youth Violence Prevention funds. This program reports to the Office of Mayor Charlie Hales. Funds are administered through City Special Appropriations.
- c. The Mayor, or the Mayor's designee, or the Grant Manager is authorized to renew this grant agreement in the same or different amount subsequent to fiscal year 2016-17 provided that sufficient funds are appropriated by City Council and included within the City's approved budget.

Section 2: The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay will jeopardize the timely execution of this Grant Agreement Amendment which may impact Latino Network's ability to deliver services required under this Grant; therefore, this Ordinance is in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
