## ORDINANCE No. 187918

Establish an interim compensation rate for the revised Parking Pay Station Technician, Lead classification. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In accordance with the policies established by the City Council and based on a classification and compensation review, the Bureau of Human Resources is revising the wages of a represented classification effective October 1, 2016.
- 2. The business needs that this compensation change is intended to meet cannot be fulfilled until the wage rate is established; however, the wage rate for the classification must be collectively bargained with Laborers' 483. Under Article 27.5.2 of the DCTU contract, the City may establish interim rates during bargaining.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Effective October 1, 2016, the following interim compensation rate is established for the revised Parking Pay Station Technician, Lead:

Entry	6 Months	Year 1
\$28.60	\$31.07	\$32.00

b. When the City and Laborers' 483 conclude necessary bargaining over the appropriate salary rates, the rates may be implemented with no further action upon signing of a Memorandum of Agreement between the Director of Human Resources and Laborers' 483 and approval as to form by the Office of the City Attorney.
