

ORDINANCE No. 187922 As Amended

*Extend contracts with Veteran Government Services and Commstructure Consulting, LLC for three years and increase the combined total not to exceed amount by \$3,000,000 to provide telecommunication services (Ordinance; amend Contract Nos. 30001894 and 30003061)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Technology Services (BTS) currently contracts with VGS to provide routine maintenance of telephones and station cabling/jacks and telecommunications closets. This includes replacing disabled and broken telephone components (cords, receivers, sets) with City provided spares and deliver the replaced sets to the Telecommunications team. VGS also moves sets, lines and associated equipment, including monitors and printers from one location to another, including moves between floors and/or buildings, and completes telecommunications installations to support office moves and reorganizations. Additional work performed under this contract also includes installing structured cabling systems to support high speed voice and data communications, install miscellaneous telecommunications lines and hardware, and install telephones including designation, programming and testing.
2. Commstructure Consulting LLC is the primary fiber optic telecommunications engineering firm for the City's Integrated Regional Network (IRNE) network. Services include designing all aspects of Outside Plant (OSP) networks, including all fiber optic cabling and infrastructure that connects major City facilities, including the Portland Building and City Hall. For each location the City wants to connect to IRNE, Commstructure Consulting LLC designs the network, using a team of project managers, engineers, and drafters. They create engineering drawings and requirements that the City posts on its electronic solicitation system for the purpose of receiving bids from the contracting community to perform the work. During the design phase, Commstructure coordinates with City bureaus and utility owners, such as PBOT and PGE on right-of-way and utility location issues.
3. Due to the upcoming Portland Building Reconstruction project, services provided under both contracts are required for relocating employees out of the Portland Building to a new location(s) and will also be used as part of the renovation project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to execute a contract amendment with Veteran Government Services in the amount of \$2,500,000 and a contract amendment with Commstructure Consulting, LLC in the amount of \$500,000, approved as to form by the City Attorney, and to extend the term of the contacts for an additional three years.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because "the services provided under both contracts will be needed during the Portland Building Reconstruction project". Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
