ORDINANCE No. 187927

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsive bidder for the construction of the SW Terwilliger Sanitary Sewer Extension Project No. E10413 for \$3,800,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services is responsible for providing sanitary sewer service to all areas within its Urban Services Boundary.
- 2. The SW Powers Court pump station is failing and determined to be at the end of its useful service life; replacement is deemed not to be cost effective.
- 3. The City has designed a new 7,600-foot sanitary-only 8" sewer in SW Terwilliger Blvd. from SW Northgate Avenue to connect to the Tryon Creek Trunk sewer in State Highway OR43.
- 4. The new sewer along SW Terwilliger Blvd. serves not only the area within the City's Urban Services Boundary but also provides for future gravity sanitary service to areas currently within the Unincorporated areas of Multnomah and Clackamas Counties and areas within the Lake Oswego Urban Services Boundary.
- 5. The estimated cost is \$3,800,000. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2017 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center, WBS Element, E10413.C73.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract for the purpose described in Section 1, with the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$3,800,000.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.
