

# ORDINANCE No. 187928

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Clackamas County in the amount of \$54,000 for services related to the construction of the SW Terwilliger Blvd Sanitary Sewer Extension Project No. E10413 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services has designed and will construct a new 7,600-foot 8-inch City gravity sewer in SW Terwilliger Blvd. beginning at State Highway OR43 and terminating at SW Northgate Ave.
2. Approximately 3,700 feet of the new sewer will be constructed within Clackamas County.
3. Clackamas County will permit this project and provide administration, inspection and surveying services for the construction work occurring within their jurisdiction.
4. Clackamas County has estimated a cost of \$54,000 for these services. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10413.C73

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services, or their designee, is authorized to execute an IGA with Clackamas County, in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$54,000.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services, or their designee, is authorized to execute amendments to this agreement that do not increase total compensation beyond ten percent (10%) of the original agreement amount.
- c. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


