Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Bureau of Transportation has received an application to rename SW 9th Avenue from SW Montgomery to W Burnside Street to "Park Avenue."

While there is demonstrated support of property owners, two sections of City Code need to be waived in order to process the application in good faith. First, SW 9th is non-contiguous and also changes names twice north of Burnside (NW Park and NW 9th). The second is that the name is not of a prominent person.

PBOT is willing to undertake the process to determine if the street can be renamed, however, because of not only the support demonstrated in the application but also because of the non-contiguous and changing name of the existing street. Allowing the process to make this determination seemed both fair and appropriate.

Of the several issues the process will determine is whether the name should be "Park Avenue" or some iteration because while the Park Blocks do not have intervening addresses, there are sections with buildings where addresses could be complicated. Should the process determine that the street can be renamed, PBOT will return to City Council with that recommendation.
