Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Police Bureau accepted a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division for the FY 2016 Speed Enforcement Grant Program in the amount of \$11,997 via Ordinance 187562. ODOT has notified the City that it will grant an additional \$4,996 for the program. The additional dollars will fund the Police Bureau Traffic Division's overtime expenses associated with the program. All other terms of the original grant award are still in effect.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

ODOT is giving the Police Bureau an additional \$4,996, which brings the total grant award to \$16,993. This grant comes with a straight-time match obligation of an additional \$1,499.56; the additional dollars result in additional match obligations which will be funded by the Police Bureau's General Fund appropriation.

Community impacts and community involvement:
