Legislation title: *Amend contract with CH2M Hill Engineers for additional work completed for the Smart Cities Challenge grant project for the Portland Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$10,000 and allow for final payment (Ordinance; amend contract 31000660)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Bureau of Transportation completed and submitted applications to USDOT and Vulcan for the Smart City Challenge grant. On June 9, 2016, the PBOT team made a multi-media presentation to USDOT that included a session for the "Mayor's Pitch" and Portland's 3 minute video.

While Portland was not ultimately selected, it was a top tier candidate for the award. Over the past month, PBOT has been pursuing other opportunities to fund elements of Portland's compelling proposal. PBOT partnered with TriMet to submit an application for USDOT's Mobility on Demand Sandbox grant to move forward on elements of the Mobility Marketplace. PBOT has partnered with ODOT to fund elements of the proposal related to Columbia Boulevard focusing on improvements in this job generating district. Working with BPS and PBOT, Drive Oregon is seeking funding on electrification elements of the Vulcan proposal. Lastly, PBOT has been working with a consortium led by AT&T for Spotlight Cities which would fund elements of the proposal on 122nd Avenue.

This ordinance will allow for final payment to CH2M for work developing this compelling proposal which has brought forward partnerships to meet Portland's own Smart City challenges.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

\$10,000 budgeted to close out the CH2M contract for the Smart City Challenge.

Community impacts and community involvement:

While there is a large community involvement portion of the project this contract is providing for payment for consultant services in that projects.
