

ORDINANCE No. 187945

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro to provide funding for the analysis of projected carbon emissions based on shifts in modeled daily transportation mode patterns not to exceed \$25,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Council adopted Ordinance No. 187613 to accept a grant from the Global Philanthropy Partnership and Urban Sustainability Directors Network to support implementation of Transportation Carbon Reduction in the Powell-Division Corridor.
2. Council adopted Ordinance No. 187780 to authorize an intergovernmental agreement with Portland State University to undertake analysis for a related project titled “Deep Carbon Reduction in the Transport Sector: Impacts on Affordability and Displacement”, to address issues of displacement and gentrification through research and policy development.
3. The City of Portland is interested in using this analysis of potential displacement from the Powell-Division proposed major station areas to assess the likely change in net carbon emissions based on shifts in modeled daily transportation mode patterns.
4. Metro, as the area Metropolitan Planning Organization, is responsible for maintaining and running the regional transportation model and Council approved an IGA with Metro to provide funding for similar transportation modeling services for the Comprehensive Plan, Ordinance No. 186561.
5. The grant administrator (the Urban Sustainability Directors Network) and the funder (Carbon Neutral Cities Alliance) have confirmed that this analysis can be contracted to Metro.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an intergovernmental grant agreement with Metro in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for this grant chargeable to the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability, Cost Object PN00640001.
- c. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is hereby authorized to sign amendments for continuing data management, reporting and funding in future fiscal years if appropriations are approved by City Council.
- d. The City Council waives the competitive application process required in FIN 2.04 – Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to forward funds for services to continue work that benefits the City. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


