Purpose of proposed legislation and background information: This legislation authorizes an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, National Institute of Justice (NIJ). NIJ has agreed to provide \$30,000 for the Portland Police Bureau (PPB) to participate in the Real-time Crime Forecasting Challenge that will allow NIJ to perform an unbiased, comprehensive comparative analysis of how the different products perform relative to one another. The main goals of this project are to foster innovation by involving non-traditional crime forecasting participants and provide a mechanism to compare available methods. PPB will provide an NIJ contractor acting on behalf of the NIJ all CFS data that occurs between March 1, 2012 and May 31, 2017.

Financial and budgetary impacts: There are no financial or budgetary impacts with this legislation. The City will receive \$30,000 in reimbursement expenses to cover administrative costs.
