**Subject:** PSC Fossil Fuel Zoning Testimony

Dear Commissioners,

My name is Patricia Always. I live at 10511 W. Kingswood Circle in Sun City, AZ, 85351. I moved from Portland to spend time near my aging parents in AZ. I am writing to ask you to enact code changes to support the fossil fuel policy that was passed by Portland's City Council. Amend the proposed draft to reflect the city's fossil fuel goals: namely to

- Enact a full ban on all new fossil fuel terminals, large or small. An exception for new facilities that are 5 million gallons or less is unnecessary. The City's code changes should not allow more unit trains of dangerous fossil fuels like Bakken crude oil.
- Strengthen restrictions on expansions allowed at existing terminals by adding binding limits as well as criteria for safety and climate impacts in the City's non-conforming use review process.
- Prevent any aggregate increase in fossil fuel infrastructure in Portland.
