Subject: PSC Fossil Fuel Zoning Testimony

Dear Portland City Council and Mayor Hales:

Please amend the proposed draft to reflect the city's fossil fuel goals:

- Enact a full ban on all new fossil fuel terminals, large or small. An exception for new facilities that are 5 million gallons or less is unnecessary. The City's code changes should not allow more unit trains of dangerous fossil fuels like Bakken crude oil.
- Strengthen restrictions on expansions allowed at existing terminals by adding binding limits as well as criteria for safety and climate impacts in the City's non-conforming use review process.
- Prevent any aggregate increase in fossil fuel infrastructure in Portland.

This is essential to protect the citizens of Portland and the environment, our land, rivers and wildlife! Thank you for listening and acting for people who care, not for fossil fuel industry profit.
