TO THE COUNCIL:

On May 4, 2016, Council approved Ordinance Number 187718 for Procurement Services to competitively solicit the CIPP SE Sewer Rehabilitation in accordance with PCC 5.34. The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 00000331 on behalf of the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES), with a project construction estimate of \$2,260,000.00. BES rated the project estimate confidence level as high.

Bids were opened on June 28, 2016, and three (3) bids were received. The low bid from Iron Horse Excavation, LLC dba Oxbow Construction was responsive to the solicitation requirements, thus it is recommended that Iron Horse Excavation, LLC dba Oxbow Construction bid be accepted at the estimated unit prices quoted for a total bid amount of \$2,882,314.00.

BES along with Procurement Services identified an aspirational goal for D/M/W/ESB subcontractor and supplier utilization at 20% of the hard construction costs for the project.

The Divisions of Work identified by Iron Horse Excavation, LLC dba Oxbow Construction as being performed by D/M/W/ESB subcontractors for this project are:

In their bid, Iron Horse Excavation, LLC dba Oxbow Construction indicated their intent to self-perform the following Divisions of Work:

There is \$1,932,314.00 (67.0%) D/M/W/ESB participation on this project including the prime contractor at 58.2% and certified subcontractors at 8.8% apportioned as follows:

- DBE \$1,752,314.00 performing Saw Cutting, Traffic Control and Hauling Services, Excavation, Sewer, Bypass Pumping, Asphalt Paving, Concrete, Partial Trucking, Partial Traffic Control, Fence, Clean up, Clear & Grub and Erosion Control.
- ESB \$180,000.00 performing Specialty Sewer (CIPP) and Video.

Iron Horse Excavation, LLC dba Oxbow Construction is located in Troutdale, Oregon, and is a State Certified DBE/MBE contractor. They have a current City of Portland Business Tax Registration and EEO Certification, and are in Full Compliance with the Equal Benefits Program.

Funds are available for this project under Owner Cost Center E10682.

It is recommended that a Performance Bond and Payment Bond each at 100% of the contract amount be furnished by the Contractor. Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
