

RESOLUTION No. 37231

Adopt Administrative Rule ADM 10.01 Visual Markings for City Vehicles (Resolution)

WHEREAS, the City of Portland owns a fleet of vehicles and equipment to carry out City operations and programs; and

WHEREAS, many of the City's vehicles and pieces of equipment are used in locations visible to the public; and

WHEREAS, the public's impression of the City as an organization is enhanced when City vehicles and equipment have consistent and recognizable markings; and

WHEREAS, in 1995, City Council approved a vehicle design standard for the City; and

WHEREAS, the City's vehicle design standard has limited information to distinguish the bureaus, does not include website information, and should be updated; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Internal Business Services (BIBS) has developed ADM 10.01 Visual Markings for City Vehicles to be the updated vehicle design standard for the City of Portland; and ADM 10.01.01 City Vehicle Marking Guide (Exhibit B) as a related procedure.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Council adopts ADM 10.01 Visual Markings for City Vehicles as shown in Exhibit A as the City's vehicle design standard; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Director of BIBS shall be responsible for the review and update of this policy and for the development and implementation of related procedures and guidelines, such as ADM 10.01.01; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, ADM 10.01 Visual Markings for City Vehicles is binding City policy.

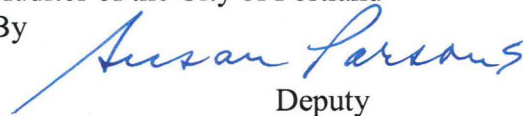
