ORDINANCE No. 187991

*Accept a grant for \$135,000 and appropriate \$50,000 from Oregon Department of Transportation to fund a Safe Routes to School program and a dedicated Safe Routes to School Coordinator in the David Douglas School District for a three-year term. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) applied to Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) for a Safe Routes to School non-infrastructure grant in the amount of \$135,000 over three years to fund Safe Routes to School Coordinator dedicated solely to David Douglas School District on 6/10/2016; and
- 2. Oregon Department of Transportation has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the Safe Routes Coordinator for \$135,000 for the term of three years, where the City will receive \$50,000 in the current FY16/17, \$45,000 in FY17/18 and \$40,000 in FY18/19.
- 3. Total in-kind match for the grant for \$37,200 will be provided through staff support in the Bureau of Transportation in the Safe Routes to School program over the life of the grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from ODOT for a Safe Routes to School Coordinator dedicated solely to David Douglas School District in the total amount of \$135,000 over three years. See grant application and award notification attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2016/2017 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND Fund 217 Business Area TR Bureau Program Expenses \$50,000

- c. The Director of the Bureau of Transportation of the City of Portland is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
- d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to

the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
