ORDINANCE No. 187992

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$4,538,856 and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for design, right-of-way and construction of the NE Columbia Blvd: Cully Blvd & Alderwood Rd project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Port of Portland applied for a grant for the design, right of way and construction of the NE Columbia Blvd: Cully Blvd & Alderwood Rd project. The project has been awarded \$4,538,856 in Multimodal Transportation Enhance Program (MTEP).
- The Port of Portland and the City of Portland will be entering into a separate agreement where the Port of Portland will authorize the City of Portland to administer the project for the Port. The City of Portland will then invoice ODOT and the Port for their services.
- 3. The project will reconstruct the NE Columbia Blvd/Alderwood Road intersection and provide signalization to the intersection, and a WB right turn lane from Columbia Blvd, and SB right-turn lane from Alderwood. Add shoulders and sidewalks at the intersection, and re-stripe left-turn pockets at EB Columbia Blvd. to NB Alderwood Road.
- 4. This IGA will accept the grand and certify the City of Portland Bureau of Transportation to design, acquire right-of-way and construct this project as a certification project using federal funds.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate since the project is as the early stages of project development phase.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the NE Columbia Blvd: Cully Blvd & Alderwood Rd project and to execute an Intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The project is in the FY 16/17 Adopted Budget
- c. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's

financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.

d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
