ORDINANCE No. 187995

* Authorize a grant agreement with LifeWorks NW in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for FY 2017 agency expenses for the New Options for Women program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Police Bureau's Sex Trafficking Unit (STU) is a program designed to reduce crime and improve the lives of people caught in the cycle of addiction and criminality. This comprehensive strategy combines resources from the Portland Police Bureau (PPB), the Multnomah County District Attorney's Office, and treatment providers;
- 2. The City contracted with LifeWorks NW (LNW) for the purpose of supporting their New Options for Women (NOW) program. This program provides trauma informed care to women in Portland in order to help them exit the sex industry. Services include addictions treatment, treatment for mental health disorders (including psychiatric care, as needed), challenging criminality, domestic violence education and support, parenting education, drug testing, and mentoring/case management;
- 3. The City funds the FY17 NOW program with a combination of U.S. Department of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program grant funds and FY17 PPB General Fund dollars;
- 4. The agreement shall begin July 1, 2016, and extend through June 30, 2017, or until funds are exhausted;
- 5. Per the City's Comprehensive Financial Management Policies, FIN 2.04 Budget, a competitive grant application process was completed and LifeWorks NW was selected as the contractor; and
- 6. Council declares an emergency exists because a delay will affect payment for approved program expenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to execute a Grant Agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Chief of Police and the Program Manager are authorized to execute amendments to the scope of services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the amount of compensation or increase the City's financial risk.

c. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to provide payment as provided under the Grant Agreement, chargeable to the applicable budgets when demand is presented and approved by the appropriate authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay will affect payment for approved program expenses. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
