ORDINANCE No.

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation as the Tax Administrator for the City of Portland Motor Vehicle Fuels Tax (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- In January 2016, City Council referred a measure to City voters for the May 17, 2016 election authorizing the creation of a program dedicated to street repair and traffic safety through a temporary, ten-cents per gallon tax on motor vehicle fuels in Portland for vehicles not subject to weight-mile tax.
- 2. A temporary ten (10) cents per gallon tax on motor vehicle fuels in Portland for vehicles not subject to weight-mile tax is estimated to raise \$64 million over four years.
- 3. On May 17, 2016, the voters passed the ballot measure authorizing a temporary ten (10) cents per gallon tax on motor vehicle fuels in Portland, not subject to weight-mile tax.
- 4. The Oregon Department of Transportation provides the most efficient and cost effective tax administration for the City of Portland's motor vehicle fuels tax.
- 5. The estimated cost for the Oregon Department of Transportation to administer the tax collections is approximately 3% of gross revenues annually, starting in FY 16-17.
- 6. This Intergovernmental Agreement will authorize the Oregon Department of Transportation to exercise all supervisory and administrative powers with regard to the enforcement, collection and administration of the Motor Vehicle Fuel Tax, including all powers specified in ORS 319.010 to 319.430, and ORS 310.510 to 310.990.
- 7. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is medium based on ODOT's experience with administering the State Fuels Tax and other local jurisdictions.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation as the Tax Administrator for the City of Portland's Motor Vehicle Fuels Tax in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The revenues from the Motor Vehicle Fuels Tax is in the FY 16/17 Adopted Budget.
- c. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.
