ORDINANCE No. 188003

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsive bidder and provide payment for the construction of the Holman Pump Station Emergency Sewer Replacement Project No. E10870 for \$774,547 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Approximately 825 feet of public sanitary sewer mains which can convey a maximum of approximately 5000 gallons per minute to the Holman Pump Station are severely deteriorated and in need of replacement.
- 2. An Emergency has been declared by Commissioner Fish pursuant to Title 5 of the City Code and Charter, authorizing the City to enter into an Emergency Procurement Contract to perform the sewer repairs. The Emergency Declaration was signed on August 8, 2016.
- 3. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has prepared plans and specifications for the construction of a repair to the deteriorated pipe. BES has selected Moore Excavation, Inc. through emergency procurement procedures, to perform this work and ensure a rapid response to this emergency.
- 4. The established cost is estimated to be \$774,547. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10870.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsive a. bidder for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$774,547.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because these sewer mains pose a threat to property, health and safety, due to the severely deteriorated condition of these sewer mains. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
