*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation for the Portland Bureau of Transportation to bid and oversee the construction of the NE Columbia Blvd at MLK Jr Blvd project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On September 7, 2011, Council approved Ordinance No. 184849 and on July 23, 2014 Council approved Ordinance 186725 authorizing a total of \$3,161,000 in federal grant funding to cover costs for engineering, right-of-way, and construction of the project. As part of the IGA approved by Ordinance 186725, the State also agreed to fund an additional \$200,000 so the sidewalk on the east side of MLK Jr can be built as part of this project.
- 2. The NE Columbia Boulevard at OR 99E/MLK Jr. Blvd project will construct a dedicated westbound right turn lane on NE Columbia Blvd. at the intersection of NE MLK Jr. Blvd. and NE Columbia Blvd. A 12-foot City standard sidewalk adjacent to the proposed right turn lane and a new traffic signal will also be constructed.
- 3. This IGA will certify the City of Portland Bureau of Transportation to bid and construct this project as a certification project using federal funds.
- 4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate. We are at 95% design and are developing the final estimate.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement, approved as to form by the city Attorney, with Oregon Department of Transportation for the NE Columbia Blvd at MLK Jr Blvd project, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
