**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

City Code 2.08.120 requires the City Elections Officer to proclaim to the City Council the candidates nominated or elected and the measures approved at each City election. This report provides the official results of the municipal election held November 8, 2016 in the City of Portland as reported by Multnomah, Clackamas, and Washington County certified abstract of votes and proclaims individuals elected and measures passed.

Note: two separate Council items will be read as the formal proclamation of the passage of measures 26-179 (ballot title caption: Bonds to fund affordable housing”) and 26-180 (ballot title caption: “Establish tax on recreational marijuana sales; dedicate purposes for funds”).
