ORDINANCE No. 188124

*Authorize a Special Appropriation grant agreement with Familias en Acción in an amount not to exceed \$60,000 to provide culturally and linguistically appropriate health education to low-income Latino families in Portland (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Familias en Acción is a non-profit corporation providing culturally and linguistically appropriate health education to low-income Latino families in Portland.
- Familias en Acción's project provides evidence-based health information to Latino families who are less likely to have health insurance or access to preventive healthcare, and who are at risk for chronic diseases.
- 3. Familias en Acción submitted a grant application for the FY2016-17 special appropriations grants competitive process and was selected as one of the twenty to be awarded a grant.
- 4. Familias en Acción's mission is consistent with Council's desire to promote healthier people.
- 5. In accordance with the FY2016-17 Budget, the City now desires to make a grant to Familias en Acción in an amount not to exceed \$60,000.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$60,000.00.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Budget

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay Familias en Acción's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
