RESOLUTION NO. 20943

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Portland is petitioned from time to time by citizens wishing Council approval of matters concerning war, armament, and propaganda for and against war and limitation of armament; and

WHEREAS it is deemed necessary by the Council that its attitude be definitely known to all such petitioners; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that it is the sense of the City Council of the City of Portland that it does not favor propaganda for the promotion of war, nor does it approve of propaganda by manufacturers and others interested in the production of armament, munitions, and machines of war; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council favors all steps that honorably may be undertaken for the provision against recurrence of wars; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council that it does emphatically favor necessary preparation on the part of the Nation to protect the integrity of the United States and of its citizens from aggression, for the maintenance of law and order, and for the preservation of the Constitution and laws of the United States and of the several states.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council is opposed to propaganda for promotion of wars of imperialistic design.
