This Committee also desires the names and addresses of all organizations of foreign-born residents of whatever description.

Americanization as defined in this inquiry includes; instruction of immigrants in the English language and in civics; furnishing information, aid and service to immigrants; the counteraction of anti-American propaganda; meetings, addresses and gatherings to bring about unity of immigrant peoples in America; maintenance of information centers; the adoption of aafeguards against alien enemy activities; special attention or provisions for immigrants, and all measures and plans having for their object the bringing of native and foreign-born peoples together in common loyalty to America.

A prompt compliance with this request will be appreciated.
