

**ORDINANCE No. 188334**

Approve allocation of \$10,000 annually of Portland Children's Levy revenues to fund event sponsorships through June 2019 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:


Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City proposed and voters renewed a five-year local option property tax levy at the May 21, 2013 election to fund programs to help children in Portland.
2. The levy supports the Portland Children's Levy to make targeted investments in proven programs in the areas of early childhood development, after school and mentoring activities, prevention of child abuse and neglect, helping children in foster care succeed and mitigating childhood hunger.
3. The Portland Children's Levy seeks to annually allocate up to \$10,000 of its revenues from the property tax levy through June 2019 to fund individual event sponsorships of up to \$500 per event for community events related to early childhood, after-school and mentoring programming, child abuse prevention/intervention, foster care and hunger relief.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Portland Children's Levy is permitted to allocate up to \$10,000 of Portland Children's Levy revenue annually through June 2019 to fund individual event sponsorships of up to \$500 per event for community events related to early childhood, after-school and mentoring programming, child abuse prevention/intervention, foster care and hunger relief.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to sign and execute agreements related to the sponsorship funding authorized by subsection *a* above.
