## ORDINANCE No. 188370

\*Authorize a grant agreement with City Repair Project to complete projects related to the KABOOM! Play Everywhere Challenge Grant in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation received a \$15,000 grant from KABOOM!, Inc. to create Walking School Bus Stops that serve students at Sitton Elementary School and George Middle School.
- 2. Walking School Busses are organized efforts where students walk the same route at the same time every day to school. There are meeting places along the route where other students join and the group grows as they approach school. This helps increase safety related to traffic and personal safety.
- 3. This project will support several goals related to placemaking and Safe Routes to School. These include encouraging walking to school, creating special features in the St Johns neighborhood that will make walking for all more fun, and fostering a public involvement process that builds relationships and fosters a stronger community.
- 4. On November 22, 2016, Council ordained acceptance of the KABOOM! Play Everywhere Challenge grant.
- 5. The City Repair Project will be the primary service provider for the grant and provide services totaling \$15,000 by Grant Agreement.
- 6. The Portland Bureau of Transportation will enter into Grant Agreement No.
- 7. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with City Repair Project in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A and in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because City Repair must have funds available for project materials and staff time; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
