

ORDINANCE No. 188463

*Authorize a grant agreement with Northeast Coalition of Neighborhoods, Inc. for \$90,000 to provide cleaning services as part of the overall management of Inner Northeast/Eastside Industrial Clean Start PDX Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Northeast Coalition of Neighborhoods (NECN) is an independent nonprofit organization comprised of 11 neighborhoods in inner North and Northeast Portland, Oregon.
2. NECN provides support to neighborhoods through: information and referral; project assistance; skill-building; connections; and policy formation.
3. In the past few years the central eastside has been experiencing the impacts of the houselessness crisis.
4. With the proposal to move Right2Dream Too into the Lloyd District, there is increased concern of the potential visible livability impact to the surrounding area. Implementing a Northeast/Eastside Industrial Clean Start PDX Project will help ensure success of the Right2Dream Too move while ameliorating other livability concerns.
5. This grant funding from the City of Portland is critical to ensure that Northeast/Eastside Industrial Clean Start PDX Project moves forward.
6. The FY2016-17 Adopted Budget includes General Fund dollars that are available for the above grant in the Office of Neighborhood Involvement (\$50,000) and Mayor's Office (\$40,000) budgets. The City now desires to make a grant to NECN in an amount not to exceed \$90,000.
7. The City's Comprehensive Financial Management Policies, FIN 2.04-Budget, states that grants should be issued after a competitive application process, unless Council waives the policy in the grant ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$90,000.
- b. The City Council waives the competitive application process required in FIN 2.04-Budget.

- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payments in accordance with the grant attached as Exhibit A.
- d. Amendments to the grant agreement may be agreed to and executed by the Grant Manager or their designee provided those amendments do not increase the fiscal risk to the City.


