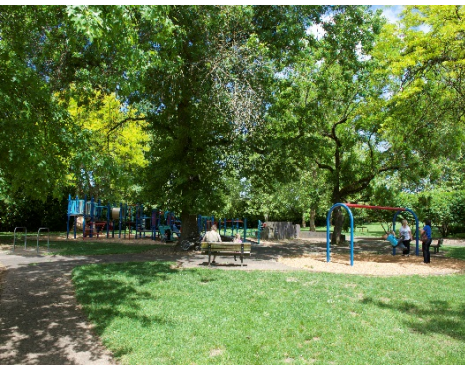

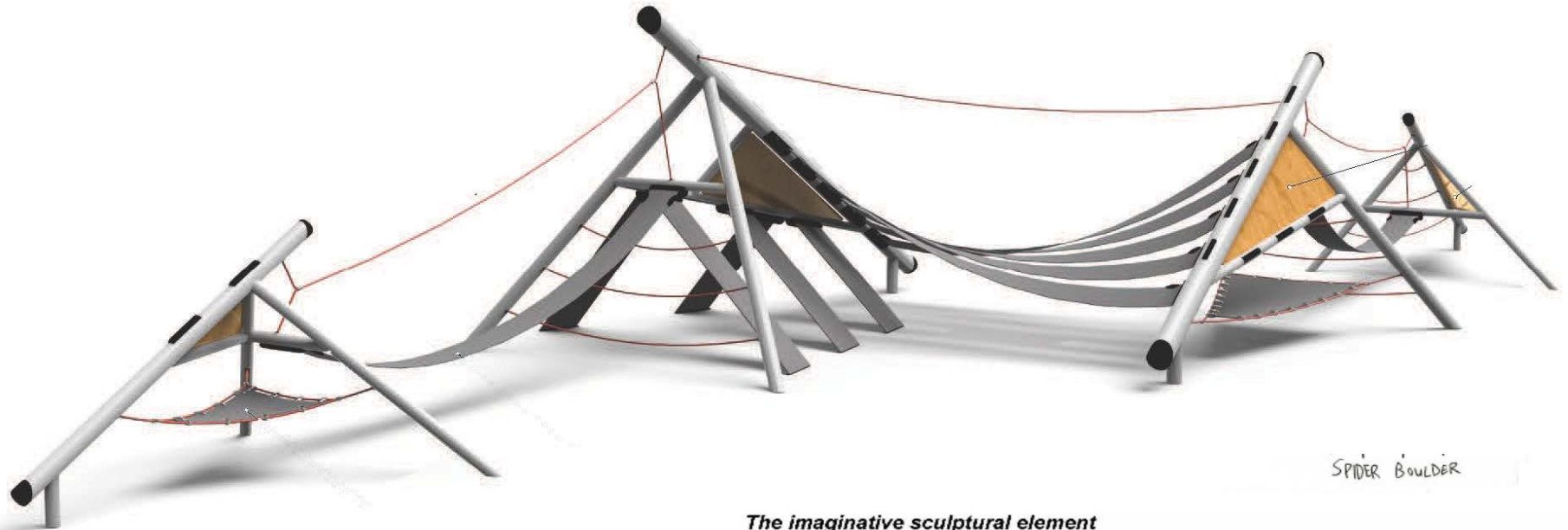

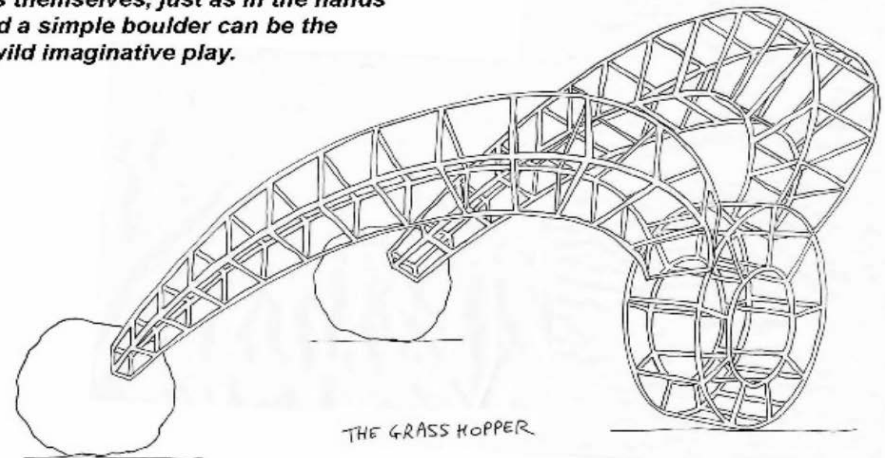

SPIDER BOULDER

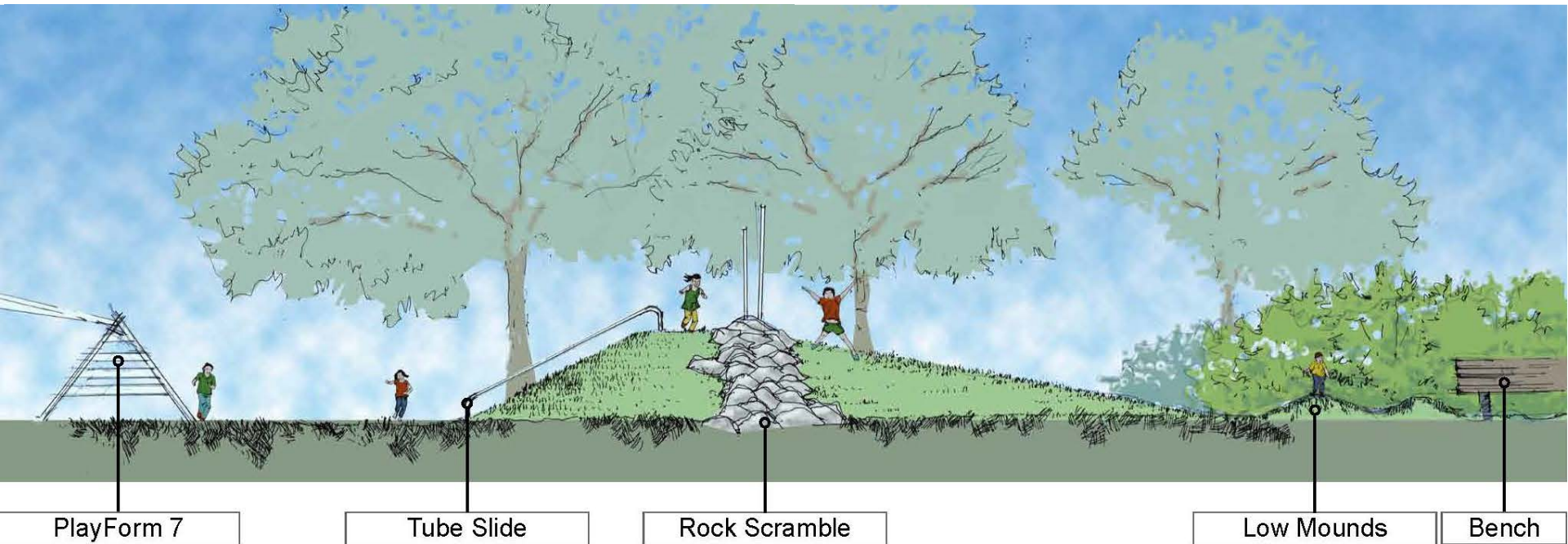
The imaginative sculptural element springs forth physically from the boulders themselves, just as in the hands of a child a simple boulder can be the root of wild imaginative play.

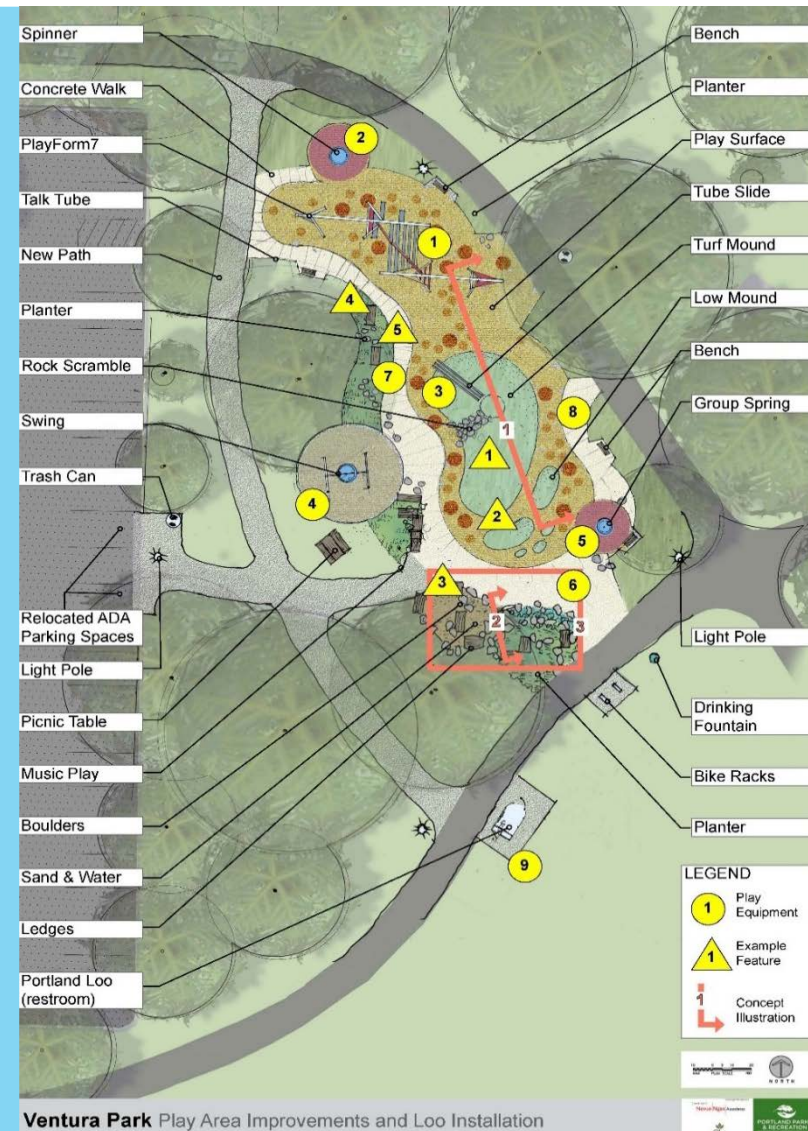
