ORDINANCE No. 188519 As Amended

*Amend relocation assistance regulations in Affordable Housing Preservation and Portland Renter Protections (Ordinance; amend Code Section 30.01.085)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On February 2nd, 2017 Portland City Council amended the Affordable Housing and Preservation and Portland Renter Protections to include relocation assistance via Ordinance 188219.
- 2. Ordinance 188219 was passed with an amendment that directed the Portland Housing Bureau to establish an advisory body comprised of representatives from landlords, tenants and other interested parties to review any proposed changes to the law and to report to Council as needed, but at least prior to October 7th, 2017.
- 3. The advisory body established by the Portland Housing Bureau has met on three occasions and compiled a set of proposed changes to the Relocation Assistance regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Relocation Assistance section of the Portland Renter Protections outlined in City Code Chapter 30.01 Affordable Housing Preservation are hereby amended as provided in Exhibit A, attached hereto.
- b. The Council directs Portland Housing Bureau to continue staffing the advisory body comprised of representatives from landlords, tenants and other interested parties to review the law and to report to Council as needed, but at least prior to October 7th, 2017.
- c. If any portion of this Ordinance or the Relocation Assistance is ruled invalid, void, or illegal by an order of the court, the remainder of this Ordinance and the Relocation Assistance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent delays in implementing the Relocation Assistance therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage by Council.
