ORDINANCE No. 188590

*Pay claim of Lori Weagant-Ray in the sum of \$47,250 involving the Portland Police Bureau (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Lori Weagant-Ray, through her attorney, has filed a bodily injury claim against the City for damages suffered in a motor vehicle accident on December 22, 2014, involving the Portland Police Bureau.
- 2. The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the total sum of \$47,250 subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$47,250 made payable to Timothy Grabe Attorney, Lawyer Trust Account.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this bodily injury claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
