Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Across the state, 1,174 AARP Tax-Aide volunteers assisted over 58,000 taxpayers, resulting in over \$54 million in refunds. With the City of Portland's FY16-17 grant, CASH Oregon was able to conduct EITC outreach and facilitate the delivery of free tax preparation services to individuals and families earning less than \$50,000 within the City of Portland.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Funding for this grant is available in the FY2017-18 budget in the General Fund Special Appropriations.

Community impacts and community involvement:

CASH Oregon Staff conducted intensive recruitment, training, and retention efforts which resulted in 496 volunteers who successfully trained to become IRS-certified volunteer tax preparers in the Tri-County area. 31% of our volunteers spoke a foreign language. CASH Oregon continues to strive toward service to a more diverse community. Four years ago they adopted a strategic plan which emphasized this on-going goal. 79% of the tax filers this year came from communities of color.
