

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION:

Subject is an irregular shaped lot located on the North side of N. Russell Street improved with 720 sq.ft. of concrete paving, 2,600 sq.ft. of asphalt paving area, gravel parking. It has 130.16' fronting on N. Russell Street and a small 30' strip along N. Gantenbein Avenue.

Property is improved with a number of buildings: a small office building, 14'x28' in size, was constructed during the latter part of 1967 with 504 sq.ft., cedar front, concrete block walls, concrete floors, built-up tar roof, base-board heat, open beam ceilings, vinyl floors. The front office has a 16 lin.ft. formica and mahogany counter. The rear office has a 19 lin.ft. cabinet and 12 lin.ft. of overhead cabinets. The front office has mahogany paneled walls. There is a lavatory finished with 2 white fixtures, a built-in vanity and an exhaust fan. There is also a built-in kitchen sink and 6 lin.ft. of kitchen type cabinets. The office building is in excellent condition.

A metal shed, $24' \times 42'$ in size, 1,008 sq.ft., finished with a metal siding, flat metal roof, concrete floors, is used for pipe storage. This was built in 1936. There is a $20' \times 16'$ canopy built at the same time which is used for crane lifting, utilizing a 1-2 ton crane.

The large warehouse building is finished with concrete floors, concrete walls, has 7 skylights and is heated by gas suspended heating units. There is a 14' x 28' mezzanine used for storage. It is finished in the interior with steel crane beams and posts to support three one-ton cranes and several Jib Cranes. This part of the building is finished with steel I-Beeam and posts support. There are numerous steel bins and steel racks used for pipe storage.

There is a small 10° x 69° open metal shed used for storage. The property is presently occupied by Albina Pipe Bending Shop whose major concern is the bending of large steel pipes.

Trade fixtures are involved concerning the rosen pit furnace, a lathe and an iron worker.
