ORDINANCE No. 121596

An Ordinance accepting a water main easement from Granite Corporation through portions of Tax Lots 37, 95 and 97, Section 32, T1N, R1E, W.M., Multnomah County, authorizing the drawing and delivery of a warrant, and declaring an emergency.

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. There is hereby accepted a 10 foot easement for water main or mains from the Granite Corporation, being more particularly described as follows:

A 10 foot easement for water main or water mains 5 feet on each side of the following described center line in Section 32, T.1N., R.1E., W.M., Multnomah County, Oregon,

Beginning at a point that is N. 89°45'10" E. 15 feet from the Southeast corner of Hilltop Addition; thence S. 0°03'10" W. 5 feet to a point; thence S. 89°45'10" W. a distance of 224.98 feet more or less to a point on the East line of S.W. Irving Street.


Section 2. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to draw and deliver a warrant in the sum of \$125 payable to the Granite Corporation, c/o Harry Coleman, 800 East Burnside Street, Portland, Oregon 97214, which warrant shall be charged to the Water Construction Fund Easements (5900.782).

Section 3. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace and safety of the City of Portland in this: In order that the necessary easement described in Section 1 of this ordinance may be available for water purposes without unnecessary delay; therefore, an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
