Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

This ordinance will close OMF Risk Management File Number 2015-003417-10. There will be no future benefits due on claim file number 2015-003417-10 that would be due and payable under Oregon Workers' Compensation Law.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This legislation will have no impact on City revenue.

Cost to the City is \$85,000. The source of funding consists of \$73,000 from the City's Workers' Compensation Fund and \$12,000 from the Bureau of Emergency Communications. All cost of the settlement is in the current fiscal year.

Community impacts and community involvement:

Areas affected by this Council item is City-Wide/Regional. This Ordinance settles Workers' Compensation claims filed against the City of Portland by Christina Pennie.
