## ORDINANCE No. 188692

Amend Public Improvements Code sections on penalty for violation, permits required and permit revocation terms in support of the Bureau of Transportation right-of-way use enforcement program (Ordinance; amend Code Sections 17.100.050, 17.23.050, 17.24.016)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On June 17, 2015, City Council adopted Resolution 37130 with the goal of Vision Zero that no loss of life is acceptable on our city streets.
- 2. With unprecedented amount of construction impacting the right-of-way (ROW) and increased community uses in the streets, safe and convenient routes for all modes of travel are critical to maintain.
- As part of Portland Bureau of Transportation's (PBOT) strategic initiative for continued investment in safety, staff reviewed ROW use programs city-wide and developed a more robust program to enforce permit conditions.
- 4. PBOT developed the ROW Use Enforcement Program to promote code compliance and enhance public safety through consistent enforcement actions for violations related to temporary traffic control, community street use, encroachments, and street openings.
- PBOT seeks to align City Code with the ROW Use Enforcement Program as the safety of the traveling public and efficient resolution to code violations are priority.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Sections 17.100.050 Penalty for Violation, 17.23.050 Permits Required, and 17.24.016 Permit Revocation are amended per Exhibit A, effective January 1, 2018.
- b. The Portland Bureau of Transportation Director or designee as authorized under Portland City Code 3.12, to adopt and amend as required, administrative rules to govern the requirements of right-of-way use enforcement in substantial conformance to Exhibit B.
