City Ordinance #61325 Adopted 9/02/1931

Established quintets, standardized street names

An Ordinance providing for a plan of systematic remumbering of buildings and renaming of streets, providing a penalty for violation thereof, and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and declaring an emergency.

> added to the street name. All streets in that section of the city south of the center line of Burnside Street and west of the Willamette river shall be designated a: "Southwest", and the profix "SW" shall be added to the otreet name.



Leading Zero Addresses

East of SW Naito Parkway and SW View Point Terrace

Southwest (SW) changing to South ("S")

Largest known current leading zero address: 02484 SW Military Road (24 blocks east) City Hall address unchanged: 1221 SW 4th Ave., not 1221 SW 28th Ave. Hillsboro / Beaverton boundary unchanged: SW 185th Ave., not SW 209th Ave.

Opportunity to install neighborhood sign caps and make street signs MUTCD compliant.





Examples of Stakeholder Issues

- 16 / 016: Another package was delivered to the wrong address.
 GPS (car navigation, Mapquest) route to the wrong address.
 I had to give the police directions when reporting a fight.
 I had to cancel my credit card because they couldn't handle the leading zero.
- 32 / 032: Gives out the leading zero but people think it is a typo and they take it out.
- 104 / 0104 Gets asked, "What do you mean, zero?"

Examples of Stakeholder Issues

121 / 0121 / Uses fake north-south address and tells people to look4247: around the corner to find the correct address.

- 231 / 0231: Uses fake letter "O" at beginning of address instead of zero to trick Internet applications to accept address.
- 242 / 0242: United Parcel Service (UPS) website won't take address.Distance of four blocks as crow flies is a mile driving.Google will geocode, but displays without leading zero.

Timing of Southwest to South Change & Standardization of Martins, Radcliffe

- Jan. 2018: Property owner notification
- Mar. 2018: Three (3) public open houses
- 2018 TBD: Council creates future sixth addressing quadrant to eliminate confusion per PCC 17.93.050
- 2018-2020: City I.T. systems phase out leading zero over 24 months; PBOT, Fire & Rescue City lead bureaus
- May 2020: "South" street name signs installed by City and County; City I.T. maintenance of leading zero eliminated
- May 2025: "SW" street name signs removed by City and County

Ordinances for Council Adoption With "cut-through" traffic prohibition

ORDINANCE No.

Rename streets west of the Willamette River and east of SW Naito Parkway and SW View Point Terrace from Southwest to South, creating a sixth addressing sextant in the City of Portland and standardize the naming of SE Martins Street and SW Radcliffe Street (Ordinance; amend Ordinance 61325)

ORDINANCE No.

Authorize an intergovernmental agreement with Multnomah County to provide authority to the Bureau of Fire and Rescue to readdress properties to enhance wayfinding, public safety and emergency response consistent with building permit responsibilities previously transferred from Multnomah County to the City of Portland for areas in unincorporated Multnomah County

ORDINANCE No.

Create new City Code section 16.70.900.A.10 to prohibit crossing of private property to proceed from one street to another, except for operators of vehicles who stop on the property for the purpose of procuring or providing goods or services (Ordinance; amend Title 16)
