Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

To reappoint one community member to the Portland Parks & Recreation Bond Oversight Committee for a term to expire December 31, 2020.

The Committee convenes periodically to review progress on Bond project improvements, monitor spending (“Program Progress”), and consider and recommend project modifications if inflationary increases in construction costs exceed current budget estimates. The Committee reports annually to City Council regarding such Program Progress, which sets forth the Committee’s recommendations for project modifications.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Community impacts and community involvement:

The Portland Parks & Recreation Bond Oversight Committee is composed of five community members appointed to either a two or three-year term by Portland City Council; members may be reappointed.

The Committee will convene periodically to review progress on Bond project improvements, monitor spending (“Program Progress”), and consider and recommend project modifications if inflationary increases in construction costs exceed current budget estimates. The Committee will report annually to City Council regarding such Program Progress and shall set forth the Committee’s recommendations for project modifications, if any.
