Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Fresh Out's community based re-entry program, helps recently incarcerated African-American men and women, transition back into the community after periods of incarceration. Fresh Out offers referral and support services to help reduce recidivism in African-American men and women. Providing services such as short-term rental assistance, utility assistance, employment support, gang intervention, and mental health treatment and referral.

There has been no previous Council action directly related to this legislation. This legislation does not support or change any specific City policies.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Funding for this grant is available in the FY2017-18 budget in the General Fund Special Appropriation.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This legislation is geared towards the African American population, particularly men and women who were recently incarcerated. This legislation will help contribute to city livability, but helping individuals transition back into the community after period of incarceration, help reduce recidivism and hopefully put these individuals towards a path of gainful employment and being better contributors to society.
