ORDINANCE No. 188750

*Authorize a grant agreement with The Independent Publishing Resource Center in an amount not to exceed \$20,000 for their Capacity Expansion Programming Initiative (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. For over 19 years, the IPRC has provided artistic services to more than 30,000 Portland area residents through the use of their center, workshops, and a variety of outreach programs. The IPRC is at the heart of Portland's do-it yourself arts and literary community, providing a creative home for many local artists and serves as an incubator for the independent creative spirit that helps make Portland unique.
- 2. Through the hiring of a full-time outreach coordinator, the IPRC will be able to expand their business hours, enhance their capacity to serve the citizenry of Portland, further develop programming at the Zine Library and expand media literacy programming at both their center and throughout the greater Portland area.
- 3. The hiring of an outreach coordinator will enable the IPRC to reorganize staff responsibilities, allowing for a four-fold expansion of outreach programming both in and outside of the center.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, with The Independent Publishing Resource Center, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$20,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could result in a delay in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
