ORDINANCE No. 188754

Amend Intergovernmental Agreement with Oregon Department of Transportation to undertake the N/NE Columbia Intelligent Transportation System Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Initial construction costs for this project were estimated at \$500,000. This amendment will add \$600,000 from Federal-Aid Surface Transportation Program (STP) with a local match of \$125,899
- 2. The City entered into Contract (IGA No. 30517) with Oregon DOT on 3/10/2016 for the installation of ITS equipment along NNE Columbia.
- 3. This ITS project will improve traffic operations and safety along NNE Columbia corridor.
- 4. The project will include additional vehicle detection, Travel Time monitoring devices, and closed-circuit TV monitoring cameras at strategic points in the corridor.
- 5. The City staff will use these technologies and communications to monitor traffic conditions, relieve congestion, enhance safety, and to increase efficiency of the existing transportation system.
- 6. Construction costs for this project are funded with a Federal-Aid Surface Transportation Program (STP) grant for \$ 1,100,000 with \$125,899 (GTR) of local match required.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement similar in form to the agreement attached to the original of this ordinance, and by this reference made a part hereof.
