Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The project will construct ITS infrastructure along N/NE Columbia Corridor (from Columbia at 41st to Columbia/Lombard at Burgard). The project will install CCTV cameras, vehicular traffic and bike monitoring stations, fiber communications, Bluetooth readers, freight and transit priority, and integrate most of these devices with City's ODOT's, and Tri-Met's Transportation Centers. This project is part of the larger City and Regional Advanced Traffic Management System, and provides the minimum project elements that will yield significant benefits in the corridor.

There will be no long financial impacts for the City. All changes along the corridor will improve and update traffic signal equipment. There are no negative impacts
