ORDINANCE No. 188762

*Authorize a grant agreement with African Youth and Community Organization in an amount not to exceed \$30,000, to support the Standing Together Against Hate project. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. AYCO serves immigrant and refugees in the Portland Metro area and opens its doors to anyone seeking community based support. The organization promotes community connections, trust and the capacity to bridge understanding between mainstream communities and African immigrants. Their clients experience interactions that instill fear for their safety.
- 2. AYCO is committed to promoting equity through all their programs. As the current political climate reinforces intolerance toward immigrants, particularly Muslim immigrants, AYCO has felt an increasing urgency to promote a sense of safety and belonging while also standing strong in their efforts to bridge cultural divisions.
- 3. The FY2017-18 budget includes funding in the General Fund Special Appropriations for the above grant. The City now desires to make a grant to the African Youth and Community Organization in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the African Youth and Community Organization, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$30,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding will affect the AYCO ability to provide the service for this project; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
