ORDINANCE No. 188789

*Authorize a grant agreement with the Center for Intercultural Organizing dba Unite Oregon not to exceed \$30,000 to support the Hayaan project to educate immigrant communities on their rights and how to protect themselves against hate actions (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Center for Intercultural Organizing has decades of experience organizing Immigrants, refugees, people of color, and low-income Oregonians to address racial justice and human rights issues in Oregon.
- 2. The Center for Intercultural Organizing doing business as Unite Oregon has received and compiled several hundred hate attacks and incidents data across their three chapters statewide.
- 3. Led by people of color, immigrants and refugees, rural communities, and people experiencing poverty, the Hayaan Project works across Oregon to build a unified intercultural movement for justice.
- 4. The Hayaan Project embodies a strategy led by immigrants and refugees, to train the Portland community on rapid response to hate incidents, provides direct legal assistance and community support to victims of hate, collects and reports hate incident data, and mobilizes impacted communities and allies to push back against policy attacks.
- 5. The FY2017-18 budget includes funding in the General Fund Special Appropriations for the above grant. The City now desires to make a grant to CIO in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the Center for Intercultural Organizing doing business as Unite Oregon Community Organization, as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$30,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2017-18 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding will affect Center for Intercultural Organizing's ability to educate immigrant communities on their rights and how to protect themselves from hate incidents and provide legal referrals as incidents of hate arise; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
