ORDINANCE No. 188791

*Pay lawsuit of Leta Klutz in the sum of \$80,000 involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Leta Klutz, through attorney Gregory Kafoury, has filed a bodily injury lawsuit against the City for injury suffered in a fall involving the Bureau of Transportation on October 30, 2014.
- 2. The lawsuit has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the lawsuit at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends the lawsuit be compromised for the total sum of \$80,000 with the amount of \$80,000 still due, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in a. the amount of \$80,000 made payable to Kafoury & McDougal Client Trust Account.
- Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount b. set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and Section 2. costly delay in settling this bodily injury lawsuit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
