ORDINANCE No. 188794

 Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Marion County for disposal of infectious waste at the Covanta Waste-to-Energy Facility. (Ordinance; Contract 30006083)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland Fire & Rescue must routinely dispose of infectious waste as defined in ORS 459.386.
- 2. Marion County, a political subdivision of the State of Oregon, provides for disposal of infectious waste through a contract with Covanta Waste-to-Energy Facility located in Brooks, Oregon.
- 3. Marion County is authorized to grant to the City of Portland, the non-exclusive right to deliver infectious waste to the Covanta Waste-to-Energy Facility, at a rate to be determined by Marion County, but not to exceed \$5,000 annually.
- 4. Portland Fire and Rescue agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement, attached as Exhibit A.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Commissioner-in-Charge and Auditor are authorized to execute an agreement for the disposal of infectious waste with Marion County in a form substantially similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because Portland Fire & Rescue has a critical need to dispose of infectious waste. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
