ORDINANCE No. 188803

*Authorize a grant agreement with The Black United Fund of Oregon in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 for their Mentor4Success program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Black United Fund of Oregon is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to assist in the social and economic development of Oregon's low-income communities and to contribute to a broader understanding of ethnic and culturally diverse groups.
- 2. In 2005, MESO was created on the notion that low-income individuals could achieve economic security through entrepreneurship. This led them to match individuals from disenfranchised, displaced, low-income, immigrant/refugee, unbanked, minority and underserved communities, with all the services and support needed to succeed in business.
- 3. MESO's access to capital for African-American entrepreneurs' initiative will address challenges and disparities that sometimes hinder The African-American community from achieving economic prosperity.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, with The Black United Fund of Oregon as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$15,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could result in a delay in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
