

ORDINANCE NO. 188818

*Authorize application to the Oregon State Historic Preservation Office for a Certified Local Government Grant in the amount of \$12,500 to support the City's historic resources program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Oregon State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) invited the City of Portland to apply for a Certified Local Government Grant funded by the National Park Service's Historic Preservation Fund.
2. The Historic Resources Program of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability is requesting the Certified Local Government Grant. The grant will fund preservation planning projects related to Portland's Historic Resource Inventory. Last updated in 1984, modernization and update of the Inventory has been identified as a priority of the Historic Landmarks Commission and relates to numerous policies of the adopted 2035 Comprehensive Plan. Funds requested for this grant total \$12,500 for the period April 1, 2018 – August 31, 2019.
3. Local match in the amount of \$12,500 will be provided by the Urban Design Program in the General Fund for FY 2017/18 and FY 2018/19. The match will be in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2017/18 and FY 2018/19 budgets of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to SHPO for a grant with an application in the amount of \$12,500, in a form substantially similar with the form attached as Exhibit A, 2018 SHPO Certified Local Government Grant Application
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so that the City can meet the timelines in the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


