

ORDINANCE NO. 188837

Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$15,500 from Oregon State Fire Marshal 2017 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness Grant for intermediate and advanced air monitoring training for the Portland Fire & Rescue HazMat Team and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. By Ordinance 188276, passed March 15, 2017, Council authorized Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) to apply to the Oregon State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness (HMEP) sub-grant in the amount of \$15,500 to receive specialized training in the prevention and mitigation of incidents involving hazardous materials.
2. OSFM has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant in the amount of \$15,500 for the requested training.
3. The grant requires a 20% match contribution. The City of Portland, PF&R matching funds of \$3,875 will be provided in the form of in-kind contributions of salary and benefits for the firefighters attending the training. The matching funds are in PF&R's FY18 operating budget.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon State Fire Marshal for intermediate and advanced air monitoring training in the amount of \$15,500 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2017/2018 budget is hereby amended as follows:


