## ORDINANCE No. 188927

Authorize a contract with Parametrix, Inc. for professional engineering services for the Lombard Pump Station Upgrade Project No. E10920 in the amount of \$959,746 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
  - 1. The City of Portland owns and operates the Lombard Pump Station which was built in 1983. The aging facility needs electrical and control upgrades, equipment replacement, concrete repair, and forcemain condition assessment, to improve operational reliability.
  - 2. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) has need of a consulting engineering firm to provide professional engineering services for the Lombard Pump Station Upgrade, BES Project No. E10920.
  - 3. The services were competitively solicited under RFP No. 00000608 and awarded in accordance with PCC 5.68.
  - 4. The established cost is \$959,746 with D/M/W/ESB participation of \$409,786 or 42.7%. The level of confidence is high. Base contract without contingency tasks estimated cost is \$809,286, with D/W/M/ESB participation of \$316,928 or 39.1%. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY2017-FY2018 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Project Number E10920.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with Parametrix, Inc. for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$959,746.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
