Current Administrative Rule PRK-1.02:

23. Administration of Non-Park Property Program

The Property Manager for Portland Parks and Recreation shall have the day-to-day responsibility and authority to administer this policy and related procedures and is authorized to enter into negotiations on behalf of the City regarding the general administration of non-park use of Portland Parks and Recreation property. The Chief Planner and the Manager of Park Operations shall be consulted and may approve or deny the request for non-park use. Subject to the authority granted to the Commissioner in Charge under Section 20.12.380 of the City Code, the City Council has final authority to grant permits, easements or other instruments governing non-park use of park property.

Proposed Administrative Rule PRK-1.02 (with tracked changes):

23. Administration of Non-Park Property Program

The Property <u>& Business Development</u> Manager for Portland Parks and Recreation shall have the day-today responsibility and authority to administer this policy and related procedures and is authorized to enter into negotiations on behalf of the City regarding the general administration of non-park use of Portland Parks and Recreation property. The Chief Planner and the Manager of Park Operations shall be consulted and may approve or deny the request for non-park use. The Director may designate the Property & Business Development Manager the authority to approve or deny requests for non-park use. Subject to the authority granted to the Commissioner in Charge Director under Section 20.12.380 Sections 20.08.070 and 20.12.080 of the City Code, the City Council Commissioner in Charge has final authority to grant or deny permits, easements or other instruments governing non-park use of park property.
